Dear Parishioners and Friends,

On Wednesday, the readings from the Mass (Matthew 10:1-7) tell us how Jesus appoints his disciples and names them as follows: "First Simon, who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Zealot and Judas Iscariot, the one who was to betray him."

It is interesting for us to Google the different Apostles' names and learn something about them. There were two sets of brothers and three pairs of Apostles who shared the same name (Simon, Judas, and James). For example, James the son of Zebedee is also called James the Great, and James the son of Alphaeus is also called James the Lesser. These are fun facts that help us to understand the Scriptures better.

Last weekend, the chairperson of the Parish Finance Council, Sharyn Mudgway, presented the Parish Finance report for 2023. There are spare copies of it for you to read in the foyer of the church.
