Rite II Reconciliation for Lent.

This week, we have our Rite II Reconciliation for Lent on **Friday**, **4 April at 7.00pm**, and again next **Friday**, **11 April**, at St Mary's Tauranga, at **6.00pm**.

Sunday's Gospel (Luke 15:1-3, 11-32) is a powerful passage for our prayer and reflection as we prepare for Confession. The Father welcomed the Prodigal Son back without question, giving him a ring for his finger, a robe, sandals for his feet, and a joyful celebration. God the Father waits for us to return to Him and rejoices when we do—a beautiful and healthy image of God's love. At times, we may also find ourselves in the role of the elder son, bitter and resentful. Though he had remained faithful, he struggled to accept his brother's actions and his father's forgiveness. We are all prodigal sons and daughters, whether like the younger son who strayed or the elder son who struggled with forgiveness. But most importantly, God the Father is always welcoming us back with open arms. He never tires of forgiving us—but as Pope Francis reminds us, we often tire of asking for forgiveness.
